## THE LORD OF LIFE

At this bountiful time of year, our Sunday readings teem with life and abundance. Both the first reading, from the book of Wisdom, and the Gospel passage from Mark assure us that God did not make death or even will us to be ill. Illness and death entered the world through the presence of evil, the Wisdom author tells us. Mark's stories of Jesus healing a hemorrhaging woman and resuscitating a dead little girl make it clear that Jesus is from God. As the Son of God he does not will that anyone suffer illness or death. In the face of such power, the second reading, from Paul's Second Letter to the Corinthians, provides a stark contrast. Jesus, who could raise the dead to new life, "though he was rich, for your sake he became poor" (2 Corinthians 8:9). Our gift of new life from Christ demands our response in charity.


## Upcoming Events

## Religious Education

New Parents/Guardians: Registration forms are available for you to register your child for religious classes for the Fall. Please return all forms to the rectory. If your child attends public school and is in Kindergarten through grade 8, he/she should be attending Religious Instructions. If your child attends Catholic School, he/she should be attending preparation classes to receive the Sacraments at Sacred Heart or wherever you worship on Sundays. We are appealing to parents, teachers, and group leaders to help us ensure that all children are registered in our Parish's Religious Education Program for the upcoming pastoral year. We are accepting applications for kindergarteners to the 8th graders (ages 5 to 13), even if they attend Catholic Academies.
